Translate the following verbs. Collect as many clues as you can to help distinguish between forms present and imperfect of to be, to go; perfect and pluperfect of to know. (E.g. is there an iota? Is there an augment?)

Using the clues (both augments and stems in Lesson 36), identify the following forms and translate.

εἶμι I (will) go (pres. used as fut.)	ἴμεν We (will) go
εἶσι He/she/it (will) go	ἴσασι (ἴ) They know
εἶς You (sg.) (will) go.	ἴασι They (will) go
ἴτε You (pl) (will) go	ἤδης (ἤδησθα) You (sg) knew (plu.pf.)
ἤδεα I knew (pl.pf.)	ἴσαν They knew (plu. pf.)
ἤδη He/she/it knew (pl. pf.)	ἦσθα You (sg.) were
ἴστε You (pl.) know	ἦμεν We were.
ἦα I was	ἦσαν They were.
ἦεν (ἦν) He/she/it was.	ἦτε You were.
ἦια I went.	ἦομεν (ἦμεν) We went.
ἦει He/she/ it went.	ἦισαν (ἦσαν) They went.
ἦτε You (pl.) went.	οἶδας (οἶσθα) You (sg.) know (pf.).
οἶδα I know (pf.)	ἴτε You (pl.) (will) go.
οἶδε He/she/it knows (pf.)	ἴδμεν We know (pf.)
ἦεις or ἦεισθα You (sg.) went.	έστέ You (pl) are
